STUDY QUESTIONS:

4a i. What is the difference between the Tabernacle and the Temple? 1Kgs8:4;2Chro.1:4-6; 3:1; Num.7:9(see Num.4:10,15;9:15-24;10:11-12,33-36).

ii. Discuss the gradual decline in certain standards of the physical temple culminating in Jesus' statement in Matt.24:2 "not one stone... that shall not be thrown down." Haggai 2:3 (1Kgs12:25-33; 14:16,22-27;Ezra2:69;3:11-13;2Kgs24:13;25:8-15;2Chro.36:14-23;26:16-21;24:15-21Jer.7:1-12;Mk11:15-18).
